ELIGIBILITY

Applicants **must meet** the following criteria:

- Must be a local resident of SWFL (this include; Lee, Collier, etc..)
- o Must have a financial need Please see application
- o Must desire to work and reside in SWFL upon graduation
- o Must enroll at Southwestern Vocational Training for a State approved program
- o Must agree to work for Golden Care for at least 12 months
- Must be able to read, write and speak English.

REQUIREMENTS

Candidate can apply for this scholarship throughout the year. The committee has 30 days to review and decide. To be considered, you must submit:

- A completed Scholarship Application Form (typed or printed)
- One-page typed personal essay describing reason he or she should receive the scholarship
- A copy of driver's license
- 2 recommendation letters 1 personal and 1 professional
- A copy of **High School or GED** diploma or transcript, if available

• Proof of registration at SWVT for a state approved program (receipt, registration receipts are acceptable)

AWARD

- Scholarship applicants <u>MAY</u> be interviewed by a scholarship committee if there is a tie in order to make final determination on the scholarship award.
- The Golden Care Scholarship Award recipient will be notified of the selection within 30 days
- Awarded scholarships may only cover tuition or a specific amount may be awarded.
- Student is responsible to pay for all other fees such as State exams and registrations fees etc... that scholarship does not cover.
- Awarded scholarships <u>must be used within 60</u> days from the day it was honored
